

**MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING
ON
ACADEMIC COOPERATION**

BETWEEN

**UNIVERSITAS INDONESIA, REPUBLIC OF INDONESIA
AND
THE UNIVERSITY OF NOTTINGHAM, UNITED KINGDOM, MALAYSIA AND CHINA**

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING (hereinafter called "MOU" on Academic Cooperation between UNIVERSITAS INDONESIA (hereinafter referred to as "UI or "Party" or "University") and The University of Nottingham (hereinafter referred to as the "Nottingham" or "Party" or "University"), collectively referred to hereinafter as the "Parties" or "Universities". **WHEREAS :**

1. The Parties agree to enter into an agreement for academic cooperation;
2. The Parties recognize that the academic cooperation will promote further educational collaboration and cultural understanding and have agreed to further continue their common interest in promoting the mutual cooperation in the area of education and research; and
3. The Parties agree to implement the MOU under the terms and condition hereinafter set forth.

HAVE AGREED AS FOLLOWS:

**ARTICLE 1
PURPOSE AND OBJECTIVE**

- (1) The purpose of this MOU is to make possible and to facilitate the exchange of students, scholars and educational resources between the Parties, based upon principles of mutual equality and the reciprocity of benefits;
- (2) The objective of this MOU is to strengthen ties between the Parties and to promote academic cooperation and to further the understanding of the culture of the two countries concerned.

**ARTICLE 2
SCOPE OF ACTIVITIES**

The scope of activities of the MOU shall include:

a. ACADEMIC STAFF PROGRAMME

1. Visits by academic staff will be encouraged for the mutual benefit of the Parties. Each Party will accept scholars from the other Party. Suitable arrangements will be made for the exchange of visiting scholars for collaboration in teaching and in research on a case by case basis;
2. The host university will provide the normal services for visiting scholars including access to laboratory facilities;
3. The host university will assist, as far as possible, in arranging accommodation for the visiting scholar, and will assist the visiting scholar in matters of immigration, stay, and working permit, medical emergencies, language and local customs

b. JOINT RESEARCH PROGRAMME

1. The Parties will seek opportunities to cooperate in research. The details of specific research proposals will be determined by the mutual agreement of relevant faculties at the two Universities;
2. Any Intellectual Property Rights resulted from the cooperation will be discussed and arranged in a separate agreement.

c. CULTURAL EXCHANGE PROGRAMME

1. To facilitate academic and cultural exchange, the exchange of research materials, publications and information will be encouraged;
2. Each university will invite the other, when appropriate, to participate in conferences, symposia and short visits. Joint educational programmes and joint curriculum development are also encouraged.

d. STUDENT PROGRAMME

The student exchange programme will be detailed in a separate agreement. Other activities under the student programme may include joint supervision of postgraduate students, and the provision of library access and academic assistance for doctoral research students. Such activities shall be negotiated and agreed to by Parties on a case-by-case basis. /s/

**ARTICLE 3
CONTRIBUTION BY UNIVERSITIES**

In accordance with the prevailing laws and regulations in Indonesia and the United Kingdom, Malaysia and China and subject to personnel and budget limitations, the universities shall:

- a. Seek finance of joint activities from sources available to them;
- b. Provide necessary funding to assist in the implementation of activities;
- c. Assign qualified experts and lecturers to assist in the implementation of activities under this MOU.

**ARTICLE 4
AMENDMENTS, EFFECTIVE DATE, DURATION AND TERMINATION**

- (1) This MOU can be amended by mutual consent of the Parties. Any amendments to this MOU can only be made in writing and after consultation and mutual consent of the Parties. Such amendments, once approved by the Parties, will become part of this MOU;
- (2) The effective date of this MOU shall be the latter date on which the Parties sign this MoU;
- (3) This MOU shall remain in force for a period of three (3) years from the date of the last signature. The MOU may be extended by written mutual consent of the Parties;
- (4) The MOU may be terminated by either Party giving written notice at least 6 (six) months in advance to the other Party. The event of termination will not prevent participants from completing their activities at the host institutions;
- (5) In case the MOU ceases to be effective on the account of termination or expiration, the provisions of all valid Plan of Operation documents shall continue to apply to the extent necessary to secure the implementation of existing activities as agreed upon in the Plan of Operation documents.

**ARTICLE V
COMMUNICATION**

- (1) Any notice or request given or made by one Party to the other under this MOU shall be in writing in the language of English and shall be addressed by all means to the Party's principal office as is designated in writing hereinafter;




